Vandalism

The Berlin Police Department is currently investigating the vandalism of over thirty vehicles and three buildings within its jurisdiction. Reports of damaged vehicles in the downtown started around 10:00 pm on 1-25-2015 and led to discovery of several vehicles and buildings that were spray painted. During the morning hours of 1-26-2015, additional calls of spray painted vehicles were reported leading officers to discover more vehicles damaged off of Broad Street. The suspect or suspects spray painted words, vulgar statements and vulgar objects on the vehicles in various colors. All citizens and guests are advised to check their vehicles for possible damage. If damage is located please contact the Berlin Police Department and your insurance company to file a possible claim of damage. As a crime prevention suggestion, vehicles should be parked in well-lit areas and preferably on the property of the owner. The Berlin Police Department request that if anyone has any information about the vandalism or if anyone saw anything suspicious during the late evening of 1-25-2015 or early morning hours of 1-26-2015 to call (410) 641-1333.
