**Questions and Answers**

- 1. Would the Town of Berlin consider any other sites (4+ acres) that would allow for a 1MW or larger community solar installation?**

The Town would not consider other sites. The Town wants the Community Solar Garden close to the Berlin Electric Utility substation. The Town is not interested in a 1MW or larger solar installation at this time.





